### **Class News**

**Class 3** will be continuing with their work looking at characters from Danny the Champion of the World in literacy. The focus will be on speech marks and indirect speech. In topic time the class will be leading the learning on aspects of Chinese history or culture. They have been preparing group power points and information leaflets to present to the class. We shall be making a start on our D&T unit to design and make a musical instrument which links to our science work on Sound. Thank you to those who have already sent in your donations towards the cost of attending the Music Festival at Thomas Adams next week, if you haven't already done so could you please let me know whether you will be able to contribute. I am very aware that you have had two things to donate funds towards and with this in mind I am currently assessing the feasibility of the Lego Morning in the last week as I have had several slips returned indicating that you are unable to contribute on this occasion. I will inform you on next weeks mail on Monday whether we will proceed with this event. It was just a fun activity at the end of term.

**Class 2** – this week in literacy we will continue to work on reports. In maths we will work on sorting data using a Venn and Carroll diagram. We will also plan for a child initiated day on 'pirates' next Monday, where children will take charge of their own learning for the day. They may come home asking you for things to bring in for this day, depending on what they plan to do. Swimming is on Tuesday.

**Class 1** –class one are beginning a new literacy unit based on patterned rhyme. We will be sharing and performing a selection of patterned rhymes and poems this week. In numeracy the older children will begin to use a blank number line to aid them with addition and subtraction. The reception children will be understanding addition as grouping a set of objects. In science, we will continue work on pushes and pulls.
