### **Class News**

**Class 1 –reminder: forest school next week will be taking place on the school site. The children can be collected from school at 3.15.**

**Class one** are beginning a mini topic called superheroes today. we will finding out about our favourite super-heroes, planning playground equipment for a super-hero to use, reading and performing superhero poems and talking about what makes a super-hero.

In maths we will be continuing our work on addition and subtraction working on money. In science, we will be planning and starting our own independent investigation. Class one will be attending the singing festival at Thomas Adams school, we on Friday morning.

**Class 2** – this week will be sats week in class 2. all children will be assessed on reading, writing and maths throughout the course of the week. Please do not worry about them and don't let the children worry either. They have all seen the type of thing they will be asked to do before, and they actually seem to enjoy them! consequently the rest of the week will be a little

lighter than usual with the focus on completing our tree sculptures, collecting more information about hedgehogs and playing some times tables games. No homework will be sent out this week.

In mathematics the class will be working on shape and starting a new unit. On Wednesday morning half the class will be going to Thomas Adams to a rounder tournament. Next Wednesday 26th, there will be a meeting for everyone who is going to Kingswood straight after school. Mrs Costelloe and Brittleton will be telling you more about the centre and giving you a list of things to take. We will also be sorting out the transport arrangements and as in previous years we will be transporting children from and to the centre in parent cars. It would be a good idea if you organise in advance of the meeting a parent partner to share the taking and picking up. Maps will be distributed at the meeting.
