Sunny Days

All this lovely sunshine has prompted me to remind everyone about children talking care in the sun. I suggest your child brings in a sunhat for lunchtime break especially if they are fair. Please send sun cream in a labelled bag and hand it to your child's TA. TAs are not allowed to apply cream but will supervise your child applying cream to ensure the right quantity is used and that it is evenly spread.
